For the Riceville Community School voters, they may vote at:
RICEVILLE CITY HALL, RICEVILLE, IOWA

***PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGES IN POLLING PLACES FOR THIS ELECTION.**

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. You may request in writing an absentee ballot from the Commissioner of Elections. An absentee ballot with instructions will be mailed to you. For further information, please contact the county auditor's office at the telephone number listed as follows: 563-547-9203.

For elections held in 2018, pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification or sign an oath of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered- such as voters registering to vote on election day-and voters who have changed precincts will also be required to provide proof of residence. A voter who cannot provide proof of identification may have their identity attested to by another voter registered in the precinct who has an approved form of identification. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification.
